# Council approves CDBG loans for downtown shops

The Morganton City Council recently approved two small business loans to help local entrepreneurs open up businesses in downtown Morganton.

In March, Council approved a \$15,000 CDBG Small Business Loan to Michael Lowther. Lowther is planning to open Overmountain Cycles at 313 N. Green St. in downtown. He plans to sell bikes; cycling accessories, bike repair services, and coffee at the shop's coffee bar.

"If it wasn't for the loans, I probably wouldn't be able to open this business," Lowther said.

Lowther also received a loan from Valdese Economic Development Investment Corporation (VEDIC).

In April, Council approved a \$15,000 CDBG Small Business Loan to Alexander Brooke Boutique, located at 115 N. Sterling St. The shop will offer reasonably priced, boutique brand "mommy and me clothing" for babies, teen girls, and women. They will also do monogramming and offer a plus-size line.
