City Receives Award for Finance

The City of Morganton Finance Department is being recognized by the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA) for its excellence in financial reporting.

The City recently received the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting from the association for its most recent Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR). It is the highest form of recognition for governmental accounting and financial reporting, and its attainment represents a significant accomplishment by a government and its management, according to GFOA. The City has received the award for the last four decades.

"We are incredibly pleased that we are again being recognized for our excellent financial reporting practices," said Finance Director Jessie Parris. "Our Finance Department works very hard to hold itself to the highest standards, and this award reflects our employees' commitment to ensuring accuracy and transparency in all of the City's financial reporting."



Catawba Meadows Greenway Riparian Buffer

The City of Morganton has received questions regarding the lack of maintenance along the greenway and other spaces in Catawba Meadows Park. North Carolina Land and Water Fund (NCLWF) and Morganton have a conservation easement that covers Catawba Meadows Park and runs along the Catawba River, which was entered into in 1998. For many years, the city has maintained all areas around the greenway and disc golf area. After a site visit from NCLWF, the city was informed that the maintenance was not being properly handled in those areas. A riparian buffer zone, which is a part of the easement, covers the area from the top of the Catawba River bank and goes 250 feet back into

the park. The agreement does not allow anything to be placed in this area other than the paved greenway path. The agreement does not allow any other maintenance to take place in that area other than one mowed strip on each side of the paved greenway path. There are several disc golf holes within the buffer zone that will need to be relocated and redesigned in the next several months.

Morganton still has a wonderful greenway system and a great disc golf course. Morganton strives to make the facilities look as beautiful and clean as possible. Please continue to enjoy these great amenities and create happy and relaxing memories with your family.
